# Curriculum

This term, our key questions are:

How can we make sound?

Why are jungles so wet and deserts so dry?

This term our questions will bring together many aspects of the curriculum. We will be learning about why the climate is different across the United Kingdom, the world's climates, understand how geographers use climate graphs to compare the climate of one place to another and the impact climate has on plants and animals. We will look at the climate in the Amazon Rainforest and compare this with the climate in the Atacama desert. In Science, we will be learning about sound, how sound is created, how it travels and how we can hear sound.

This term our class text is Aladdin and the Enchanted Lamp by Philip Pullman which is a story about a young boy called Aladdin who is recruited by a sorcerer from the Maghreb, who passes himself off as the brother of Aladdin's late father. We will continue to use our Whole Class Reading sessions to explore and analyse this text in detail and we will also be reading the Lion, the Witch and the Wardrobe by C S Lewis.
