



Year 5 Newsletter Term 2

<u>Curriculum</u> This term, our key question is: <u>What was it like then?</u>

We will be learning about the Victorian era and our aim is for the children to be able to build their knowledge of the similarities and differences within Victorian Britain. They will devise and explore historical questions about how life differed for the rich and poor; for men, women and children. Children will experience life as a Victorian through role-play sessions where they will learn about the Victorian schoolroom.

Our class text is 'Street Child' by Berlie Doherty and this is a story of a young boy in Victorian times. Our focus this term will be finding synonyms and antonyms for selected vocabulary and using PEE (Point Evidence Explain) to answer comprehension questions.

In Science, our topic will be materials and we will be comparing and grouping common materials, and discussing differences between materials used in Victorian times to life nowadays. We will also be developing our investigative skills through filtering, evaporating and dissolving experiments.

In Art lessons we'll be learning about typography and creating maps, in Computing we'll be using video editing software and in PSHE our sessions will focus on keeping safe which includes managing risks and safety online. Spanish this term focusses on saying/spelling days and months of the year and numbers, linking this to dates and birthdays.
