<u>Curriculum</u> This term, our curriculum focus is: How does it work?

Our history this term focusses on Ancient Greece and the story of the Trojan Horse. The children will be learning about the events, analysing evidence and making reasoned judgements. Linked to this we shall be writing recipes for Greek flat bread and Greek salads, plus reading 'Who Let the Gods Out?' by Maz Evans. Each week the children shall find the meaning of new vocabulary, analyse a new section of the book and answering comprehension questions.

Science this term is called Let's keep moving - we learn about gravity, friction, air resistance, water resistance, pulleys, levers and gars. So, lots to pack in. Last term, the science assessments were strong, they really enjoyed the space topic!

In maths, we shall be looking at division, multiplying fractions, decimals and percentages then area and perimeter. Our Spanish is all about animals, RE this term is Christianity and the understanding of Holy week. In computing, we shall be comparing paper-based and computer-based file systems, whilst in PSHE we delve into friendships and valuing one another for who we are.
