Here are some suggestions for what you might like to make:

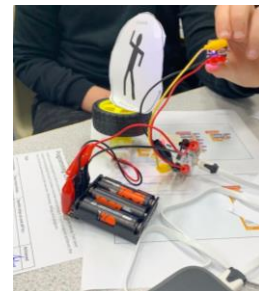
Entries should be brought or emailed into school by **Wednesday 21st February**, judging will take place the next day with the winners announced on **Friday 23rd February**.

We look forward to seeing what you come up with!

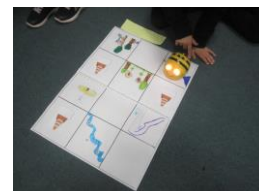
