Curriculum

This term, our key question is:

How do we know so much about where Sappho used to live?

This term sees us going back in time to 79AD to the city of Pompeii. Looking at what we can learn from the past and how it informs the future

Whole Class reading will be focusing on the book 'The Hodgeheg' and how to retrieve the answers from the text. Exploring new vocabulary and working out the meaning of the words.

Handwriting will still feature highly with ensuring letters are the correct way round and consistent in size. We will also write our own story based on the book Stardust.

Maths will be focusing money, multiplication and division. This will be supported by Sumdog with weekly activities set for the children to complete.

Any practise with money and looking at the different coins. How many different ways can they make 20p using the different coins? Practise giving change as well.
