Curriculum

This term, our key questions is:

Why do so many people in the world live in megacities?

This term our questions will bring together many aspects of the curriculum. We will be continuing our learning about how we impact our environment and the consequences this can have on the world around us. We will be learning about why so many people live in megacities as now over half of the global population now living in towns and cities. We will begin with identifying where the megacities are and where they are located, identifying the fastest growing cities around the world and here in the United Kingdom. We will use our learning to support us in identifying the advantages and disadvantages of living in cities. In Science, we will be learning about living things and their habitats, classifying living things in different ways and identifying different habitats.

This term our class text is *The Miraculous Journey of Edward Tulane* by Kate DiCamillo. This is a story about a china rabbit who was owned by a girl names Abilene who treated him with the utmost care and adored him completely. However, one day, he was lost. We will use our Whole Class Reading sessions to explore and analyse this text, the characters, the plot and vocabulary in detail. For our writing this term we will be studying the poem *The River* by Valerie Bloom. We will be looking at the structure of the poem and language choices and use this to write our own.
