Curriculum

This term we will be learning about rivers, plants and habitats with a focus on 'How does it grow?' and 'How does it flow?' Our whole class reading sessions will be based on non-fiction texts related to our topic. We will focus on answering questions in which the children comment on the author's choice of information, language, layout and illustrations in each book.



In Science, the topic is the 'Circle of Life' in which children look at life cycles of various species - including mammals, amphibians and birds. They also look at and describe the life process of reproduction in plants and animals.

Did you know?

- Trees can live for a very long time. The oldest tree in the world is a Great Basin bristlecone pine in California, which is thought to be over 5000 years old.
- Butterfies can taste with their feet. This lets them tell whether the leaves they stand on will make good food for caterpillars.
- Ninety-nine percent of all the animal and plant species that have ever lived on this planet have become extinct.
